## **Narcan/Naloxone**

- ◆ **What is Narcan?**

Narcan is a life-saving drug designed to reverse an opioid overdose. It is not a substitute for emergency medical care. Narcan is not a treatment for substance use disorder.

- ◆ **Shouldn't Narcan Only Be Used By Medical Professionals?**

Narcan is a safe medication for children and adults that only effects people with opioids in their system. It cannot be abused. The most common type of Narcan available to non-medical professionals is an easy to administer nasal spray.

- ◆ **Why is Narcan free?**

Narcan isn't free. Through grants and partnerships with Substance Use Disorder provider agencies, DACI is able to offer Narcan for those without insurance, who cannot afford the co-pay, or who have a loved one in active addiction. Narcan costs about \$130 for a two-time use spray, and can be purchased at any pharmacy without a prescription. Most pain management providers now require their patients to have Narcan if they are being prescribed opiates, and often it is not covered by insurance. First responders who administer Narcan invoice the patient or their insurance. In either case, someone is always covering the cost. The idea that Narcan is free is a popular, but false statement.

- ◆ **Isn't Narcan a "Free Pass" for Drug Users?**

The same way defibrillation is used for those experiencing a cardiac emergency, or an EpiPen is used for someone in respiratory distress due to an allergic reaction, Narcan is only used in emergency situations to prevent permanent damage or death. In 2020, there were 322 instances where Iredell County residents visited the emergency department for an Unintentional Medication or Drug Overdose. Narcan isn't just for "recreational drug users, junkies, or addicts".

# North Carolina

## Laws & Initiatives

### Good Samaritan Law

- Protects people who ask for help from 911, the police, or EMS because they or another person is having a drug overdose.
- People cannot be charged if the police find small amounts of drugs or drug paraphernalia because the person was asking for help for an overdose.
- People on probation or parole will also not get in trouble if police find small amounts of drugs or drug paraphernalia on them when they are trying to get help for an overdose.
- People who seek help for someone having an overdose must give their own name to 911 or to the police who come to help.

### Strengthen Opioid Misuse Prevention (STOP) Act of 2017

- Signed into law by Governor Roy Cooper to prevent and reduce prescription opioid misuse and reduce excessive or otherwise inappropriate opioid prescribing.

### Narcan Access Law

- Protects people who give Naloxone to someone who may be experiencing an opioid overdose. If, in good faith, they think the person is having a drug overdose and they use reasonable care to give the naloxone, they are protected from a lawsuit for giving the person naloxone.

### Legal Syringe Exchange

- Syringe exchange programs became legal in North Carolina on July 11, 2016, when Governor Pat McCrory signed [House Bill 972](#) into law.
- Under H972, no employee, volunteer, or participant of the syringe exchange can be charged with possession of syringes or other injection supplies, or with residual amounts of controlled substances in them, obtained from or returned to a syringe exchange.
